<p>1. Minutes of Last Meeting</p> <p>1.1 February meeting minutes accepted</p> <p>1.2 Actions covered in items below</p>	
<p>2. Chair's Report</p> <p>2.1 Approach Golf Course: as previously noted, recent frisbee proposition rejected, site use to be recommissioned – timeframes up to two years</p> <p>2.2 News-bites: damage to JMLb's vehicle whilst on the street has been reported, unfortunately not a rare occurrence; thanks to JJJ for escalating the incident</p>	
<p>3. Camden Lawn Subgroup</p> <p>3.1 JMLg reprised the Subgroup update papers; working party to resume original plan to start coppicing the top area of land on Saturday 10th April, having gained Council support following talks and submission of risk assessments. JMLg to lead the group of 6, which comprises sub-group members and other Camden residents who are experienced with this kind of work. Ongoing open dialogue with the Council Parks Department regarding the longer term management and vision for the land. Thanks to JMLg for his persistence and careful handling of communications</p> <p>3.2 NP reminded the committee that volunteer gardening work is also resuming at Hedgemoad Park in April, see website; contact NP if interested (and to buy his new book on the history of Hedgemoad Park, due out very soon)</p>	
<p>4. LN Subgroup</p> <p>4.1 JJJ reported that controversy continues to run high amongst areas which have submitted plans for LNs, ahead of Council Cabinet decisions being announced in May</p> <p>4.2 It is likely that the proposed running order will be posted on the Council web-site ahead of the Cabinet meeting, at which point JJJ will inform the committee accordingly</p>	JJJ
<p>5. Cleveland Bridge</p> <p>5.1 Committee reviewed the map circulated by JJJ and agreed that advance warning of the imminent closure and detailed consideration of mitigating disruption to traffic have been weak. Council webinar on the topic on 29th March is due to include JJJ's question as it relates to all routes and Camden in particular, along with the map</p>	JJJ
<p>6. CAZ Update</p> <p>6.1 RD reported that there is currently no evidence of traffic turning back along Belgrave Crescent to avoid entering the CAZ, as had been feared. Several members of the committee joined RD on commencement day (15th March) and will keep an eye on the ongoing situation, as well any changes to the CAZ rules.</p>	RD
