3.	Camden Lawn (Meadow) Subgroup  3.1 JMLg reported on a very successful first volunteer working party on 10 <sup>th</sup> April to tidy some growth at the top of the land opposite Camden Crescent. Much appreciation has been expressed both to JMLg for managing it and the team (including Cllr Tom Davies) for all their hard work; the result is a much improved view from the road, with a neat line of dead hedging. Evidence of fly tipping and rubbish within the meadow has also been reported to the Council. Cleveland Bridge 5.1 Whilst the Council's planning for re-routing traffic displaced from the imminent closure of Cleveland Bridge appears to many of the Committee to be inadequately considered, correspondence by the Chair with relevant Council personnel has not yet yielded a satisfactory response; the only option now is to "wait and see" what happens in practice and to flag up problems if and when they become apparent	
6.	<ul> <li>Update on Roles and Responsibilities Exercise</li> <li>6.1 Committee reviewed the latest version (v4) of suggested Committee roles, which has been developed by four members, and discussed ways in which the essential work of the committee can be shared within the group to develop knowledge, involvement and effort.
